



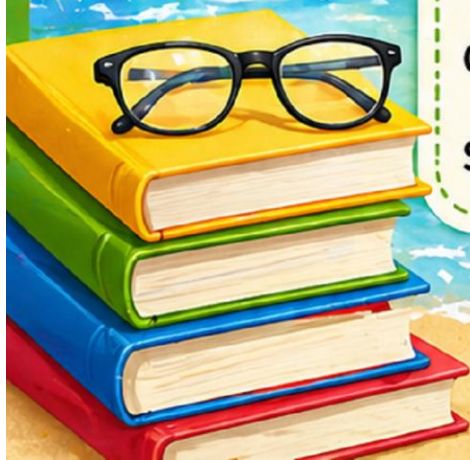

❖ **Waste management in environment**

Household hazardous waste –It has a potential threat to public health and environment. They can be highly reactive/ toxic in nature. These are home generated waste that should not be disposed of into a landfill.

Example: - drain cleaners, oil paints, motor oil, rodenticides, batteries, fluorescent lamps, medical waste, electronics waste like computer cd, cell phone etc.

Spread awareness about this waste in your society by designing a colourful poster highlighting these wastes and safe methods.

Example: Genetic features of the both dogs and cats classify them as carnivores hence they have a similar diet of meat eating.

- High Acid Stomach Type
- Short small intestines
- Digestive enzymes adapted to breakdown meat
- Absence of enzymes designed to break down vegetable matte
